NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR). The Organizing Authority is Italian Sailing Federation and Yacht Club Sanremo in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA).

For the Star Sailor League ranking the winner will get 250 pts. wherever district he will be.

- 1.1 The appendix of RRS P will apply
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the national authority, Federazione Italiana Vela, shall apply
- 1.3 RRS 32 will be changed to provide that courses will not be shortened.
- 1.4 RRS 33b will not apply.
- 1.5 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 60 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.6 RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.7 RRS A4.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats will/may be required to display Event Advertising on the forward part of the hull. Out of respect to our title sponsor, advertising for tobacco products is strongly discouraged.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30 may compete.
- 3.2 Entries shall be submitted on the Official Online Entry Form: http://www.yachtclubsanremo.it/regata/winter-series-classe-star/ not later than March 20th, 2016.
- 3.3 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under the W.S. (World Sailing) Eligibility Code shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.

3.4 For the purpose of RRS A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until: (a) All fees are paid and (b) Measurement is completed.

4. FEES

The entry fee of 200 Euro includes boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling and invitations to social events for skipper and crew. Entry fees are due at time of entry. Late entry fee (for entries made after March 20th, 2016) is Euro 300.

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 There will be no measurement before the event. Each participating boat shall have a valid Measurement Certificate in the name of the current owner, and Weight Certificate. Only boats that have completed registration, paid all entry fees, before 11.00 AM of 1 April are entitled to race. The Jury may order that a boat be re-checked during the regatta.
- 6.2 Crews shall demonstrate compliance with crew weight limits in accordance with STCR 31.1.3 prior to 11.00 AM 1 April.
- 6.3 Each boat shall show the sail number and national letters as indicated on the Official Entry Form and approved by the Measurer.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available 31 march from 10.00.

8. VENUE

Racing will be conducted gulf of Sanremo.

9. COURSES

Courses will be according to STCR 34.

10. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed.

11. BERTHING

Berthing will be available starting on March 31 at 10.00 at Yacht Club pontoons.

All boats shall be afloat starting at April 1st at 12.00 hours until the conclusion of racing.

12. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

The Organizing Authority will impose haul-out restriction.

13. TEAM AND PRIVATE SUPPORT BOATS

A yacht shall receive no outside assistance from support boats or otherwise once she has left the dock for the day until the finish of the last race of the day, except in the case of emergency and/or towing supplied by the organizer and available to all participants.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1 Perpetual Trophies will be awarded according to STCR 24.
- 14.2 Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through fifth position
- 14.3 Master's trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first in the Series for skippers aged 50 through 59 before the start of the first race. Competitors in the Master's Division will also compete for Series prizes (see 14.2).
- 14.4 Grand Master's trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first in the Series for skippers aged 60 or over before the start of the first race. Competitors in the Grand Master's Division will also compete for Series prizes (see 14.2).
- 14.5 Daily prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first in each race.

15. DISCLAIMER

The Organizing Authority shall require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property Yacht Club Sanremo. The Organizing Authority, their members, employees, officers and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

16. INSURANCE

Boats sailing in this regatta must be adequately insured Euro 1.500.000 against third party liability for racing risks. Proof of same may be requested
